



Results of 12 Month Follow-Up for Class of 2008 JILG Students (Ending May 31, 2009)

During the 12 month Follow-Up Phase, JILG Specialists helped over **96.5%** of their student's graduate high school or successfully complete a GED program! Of JILG's graduating seniors **87.5%** achieved "Positive Outcome Status" by holding civilian jobs, serving in the United States Military, or being enrolled in continuing education programs. 88.5% of JILG students reached "Full Time Placement Status" which equated to 797 students working full-time, going to school full time, or a combination of both.

At the end of the follow-up phase 928 JILG students from the class of 2008 worked one or more jobs at over 1,000 different places of employment including Wal-Mart, Jewel, UPS and Macy's. This included 71 students who were enlisted in the US Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force and National Guard. Of our employed students 63% worked full time. Besides working full or part time jobs, 54% of students were enrolled in over 200 college, universities, community colleges and technical schools across the country.

Class of 2008 Follow-Up Highlights

- * 1788 Total Students Participated in Class of 2008 follow-up
- * 1711 Students Graduated (95.75%)
- * 1498 Students (87.5%) held civilian jobs, served in the Military or were enrolled in an education or training program
- * 1043 Students (61%) held civilian jobs or were serving in the Military
- * 924 Students (88.5%) held full time placements in school or work
- * 657 Students (63%) were employed in full-time jobs
- * 933 Students (54%) were enrolled in further education programs

STUDENTS RECOVERED DURING FOLLOW-UP PHASE

Student graduation is one of Jobs for Illinois Graduates largest goals. Our JILG Career Specialists frequently monitor student's academic process, develop plans for credit recovery and provide students with academic remediation when needed.

At the end of the 2008 school year our JILG Career Specialists helped 1,570 of our 1,788 students from the Class of 2008 graduate on time with their class. Since graduation our JILG specialists have helped 65% (141 of the 217) non-graduates recover the necessary credits to earn a high school diploma or a GED.
